COZY SUNDAY I - JEWELRY: VICTORIAN to ART DECO

April 10, 2016 from 2 - 4 pm at 1508 High Ridge Road in Stamford, CT

Discover the history of jewelry and how designs and ideas from early civilizations have influenced and contributed to the modern age of this wearable art form. Nagi Osta will discuss Georgian, Victorian, Art Nouveau, Edwardian, Art Deco and Retro Moderne styles. He will share special period examples with the audience. Nagi Osta is a long time jewelry professional and owner of Nagi Jewelers on High Ridge Road in Stamford, having started his business in 1980 and now extended to a second generation. He is both a G.G.A. and CGA, and his favorite place is on the sales floor with his customers. Nagi and his team celebrate the beauty of jewelry both old and new in his showroom. COZY SUNDAY II - SPARE THESE STONES

May 1, 2016 from 2 - 4 pm at 1508 High Ridge Road in Stamford, CT

Ron Marcus, Head Research Librarian of the Stamford Historical Society, will focus on two pioneers of graveyard conservation and preservation. Samuel W. Morrell spent much of his time cataloging the graves of war veterans. He compiled lists of inscriptions of stones, many of which are no longer legible today. Dick Roberts, a former SM&NC curator and artist, spent much of his later life documenting the cemeteries in Stamford and producing illustrated maps of stones. Andrew Melillo, who has spearheaded the restoration of Northfield Cemetery and has produced the first map of the graveyard, will bring us up to the current effort to restore these historic places for future generations.
